Supplier Code of Conduct

- 1. Compliance

- **Non-Discrimination:** Suppliers must ensure equal opportunity in hiring and wages without discrimination.
- **Freedom of Association:** The supplier respects employees' right to freely associate and engage in collective bargaining in accordance with applicable laws. Employees may freely join unions or other similar organizations and communicate with the employer through their representatives.

- Suppliers must maintain safe and healthy workplaces, providing appropriate protective equipment and safety training.
- Emergency plans and response procedures must be established.

- Suppliers must adhere to environmental regulations, including proper waste and water management, pollution control, and energy efficiency practices.
- Hazardous substances must be handled responsibly with clear safety protocols in place.

5. Ethical Business Conduct

- **Integrity**: Suppliers must uphold the highest standards of integrity in all business interactions, with zero tolerance for bribery, corruption, or unethical practices.
- **Gifts and Benefits**: Suppliers must not offer or accept gifts or benefits intended to influence business decisions.
- **Confidentiality**: Suppliers must protect sensitive information shared by our company and its stakeholders.
- Data Protection and Cybersecurity: Suppliers must implement robust data protection measures to safeguard sensitive information and ensure secure handling of company data.
